4. Proposed agenda items to be presented at the Meeting: Matters falling under the authority of the General Meeting of Shareholders in accordance with applicable laws and the Charter of Airports Corporation of Vietnam.



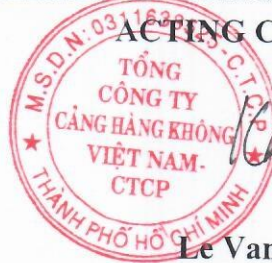
ARTICLE 3. This Resolution takes effect from the date of signing.
